



100% Cotton DK Childs Bucket Hat CY1934

Materials –

Cygnet 100% Cotton DK 100g

One ball each of shades (A) Golden 3184 and (B) Ketchup 2209

Crochet Hook: 5mm [US I-9]

Pattern notes

UK Terminology used

Measurements

One size to fit head circumference 20 in (51 cm)

A larger hook can be used to obtain a bigger adult size hat

TENSION

13 hdc and 11 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes: • When changing colours, work hdc to last 3 loops on hook. Draw new colour through last 3 loops on hook and proceed in new colour, keeping colour change to WS of work.

- Ch 1 at beg of rnds does not count as hdc
- Join all rnds with sl st to first hdc at end of rnd.

CROWN

See Diagram on page 2.

With A, ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to make ring.

1st rnd: Ch 1. 10 hdc in ring. Join with sl st to first hdc. 10 hdc.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. 2 hdc in same sp as sl st. 2 hdc in each hdc around. Join. 20 hdc

3rd rnd: Ch 1. 2 hdc in same sp as sl st. *1 hdc in next hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * to last hdc. 1 hdc in last hdc. Join. 30 hdc.

4th rnd: Ch 1. 2 hdc in same sp as sl st. *1 hdc in each of next 2 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * to last 2 hdc. 1 hdc in each of last 2 hdc. Join. 40 hdc

5th rnd: Ch 1. 2 hdc in same sp as sl st. *1 hdc in each of next 3 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * to last 3 hdc. 1 hdc in each of last 3 hdc. Join. 50 hdc.

6th rnd: Ch 1. 2 hdc in same sp as sl st. *1 hdc in each of next 4 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * to last 4 hdc. 1 hdc in each of last 4 hdc. Join. 60 hdc.

7th rnd: Ch 1. 2 hdc in same sp as sl st. *1 hdc in each of next 11 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * to last 11 hdc. 1 hdc in each of last 11 hdc. Break A. Join B at end of rnd. 65 hdc.

8th to 10th rnds: With B, ch 1. 1 hdc in each hdc around. Break B.

Join A at end of 10th rnd.

11th and 12th rnds: With A, ch 1. 1 hdc in each hdc around. Break A.

Join B at end of 12th rnd.

13th to 15th rnds: As 8th to 10th rnds.

Additional rnds may be worked here for a larger size.

BRIM

16th rnd: With A, ch 1. 2 hdc in same sp as sl st. *1 hdc in each of next 12 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * to last 12 hdc. 1 hdc in each of last 12 hdc. Join. 70 hdc.

17th rnd: Ch 1. 2 hdc in same sp as sl st. * 1 hdc in each of next 6 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * to last 6 hdc. 1 hdc in each of last 6 hdc. Break A. Join B. 80 hdc.

18th rnd: With B, ch 1. 2 hdc in same sp as sl st. *1 hdc in each of next 7 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * to last 7 hdc. 1 hdc in each of last 7 hdc. Join. 90 hdc.

19th rnd: Ch 1. 2 hdc in same sp as sl st. *1 hdc in each of

next 8 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * to last 8 hdc. 1 hdc in each of last 8 hdc. Break B. Join A. 100 hdc.

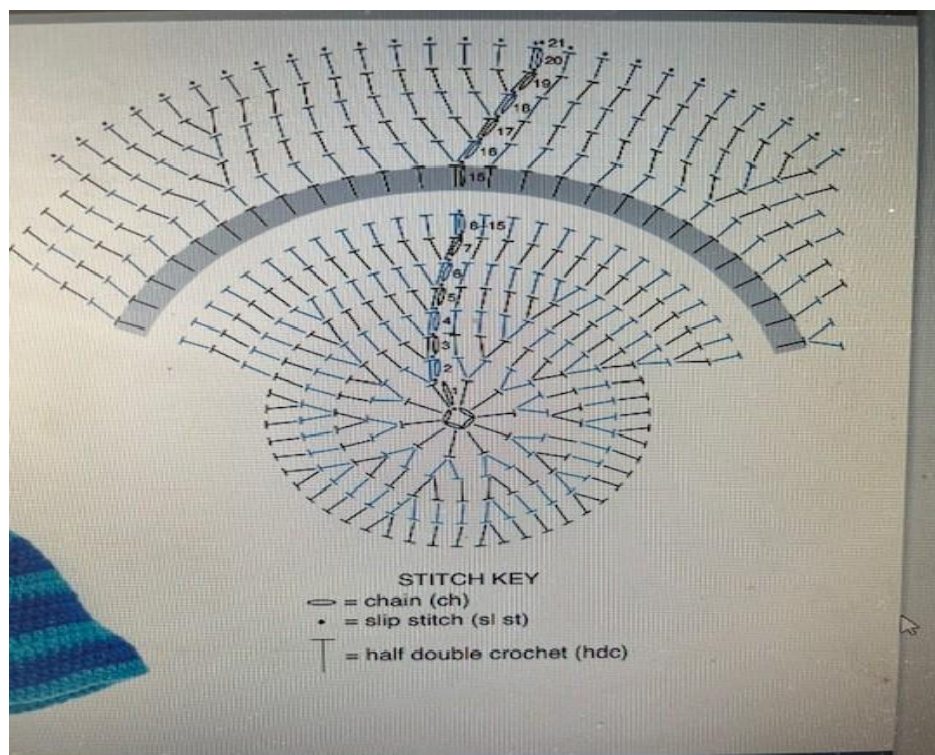
20th rnd: With A, ch 1. 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join.

21st rnd: Sl st in each hdc around. Join.

Additional rnds may be worked here for a wider brim.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.



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
