Yarn shade Finch 606										
Tropic Super Chunky 100g balls		8	8	9	10	11	13	14	16	17
10mm circular knitting needles with a 100cm cable										
Sewing needle										

TENSION

7.5 sts x 12 rows in Stocking Stitch on 10mm needles

ABBREVIATIONS

St/Sts Stitch/Stitches

K Knit

P Purl

Sl Slip

SSK Slip, slip, knit

P2tog Purl 2 stitches together

Rnd/s Round/s

Rep Repeat

Rem Remaining

Beg Beginning

NOTE

Instructions are given for sizes XS (S, M, L, XL, XXL, 3XL, 4XL, 5XL)

BODY:

The front and back panels are worked seamlessly in the round, from the hem to underarm.

Step 1: With 10mm knitting needles, cast on 78 (82, 88, 96, 104, 112, 118, 126, 134) sts.

Step 2: Work in 1x1 rib for 4 rnds.

Step 3: K to beg of rnd.

Rep step 3 for 32 (33, 35, 37, 41, 43, 47, 49, 51) more rnds.

BACK:

You will now work the upper back of the jumper only. Leave the unworked sts on the knitting needle, or transfer them to a stitch holder.

Step 1: Work in Stocking St across the first 39 (41, 44, 48, 52, 56, 59, 63, 67) sts only for 22 (24, 24, 27, 27, 29, 30, 32, 33) rows, beg with a K row. Cast off all sts

FRONT:

You will now work the remaining sts.

Step 1: Work in Stocking St for 16 (18, 18, 20, 20, 22, 22, 24, 24) rows, beg with a K row.

Step 2: K 15 (15, 16, 17, 19, 20, 22, 23, 25), cast off 10 (12, 12, 15, 14, 16, 16, 18, 18) sts, K to end.

You will now shape the neckline. Leave the unworked sts on the knitting needle, or transfer them to a stitch holder.

Step 1: P across.

Step 2: Cast off 3 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 3, 3, 3) sts, K to end. (12, 13, 14, 15, 17, 18, 19, 20, 22 sts)

Step 3: P across.

For sizes 3XL, 4XL and 5XL only

Step 4: Cast off 2 (2, 2) sts, K to end. (17, 18, 19 sts)

Step 5: P across.

For all sizes:

Step 6: K 1, SSK, K to end. (11, 12, 13, 14, 16, 17, 16, 17, 19 sts)

Step 7: P across

For sizes M, L, XL and 5XL only

Step 8: K 1, SSK, K to end. (13, 15, 16, 18 sts)

For all sizes:

Cast off all sts.

You will now work the Left side. Rejoin yarn to the rem sts.

Step 9 (WS): K across

Step 10 (RS): Cast off 3 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 3, 3, 3) sts, P to end. (12, 13, 14, 15, 17, 18, 19, 20, 22 sts)

Step 11: K across

For sizes 3XL, 4XL and 5XL only

Step 12: Cast off 2 (2, 2) sts, P to end. (17, 18, 19 sts)

Step 13: K across.

For all sizes:

Step 14: P 1, P2tog, P to end. (11, 12, 13, 14, 16, 17, 16, 17, 19 sts)

Step 15: K across

For sizes M, L, XL and 5XL only

Step 16: P 1, P2tog, P to end. (13, 15, 16, 18 sts)

For all sizes:

Cast off all sts.

SLEEVES:

The sleeves are worked seamlessly in the round, from cuff to shoulder. Follow steps twice.

Step 1: With 10mm knitting needles, cast on 14 (16, 16, 18, 18, 20, 20, 22, 22) sts.

Step 2: Work in 1x1 rib for 3 rnds.

Step 3: *K 1, incr 1; rep from * 14 (15, 16, 16, 18, 18, 20, 20, 22) times in total, K 0 (1, 0, 2, 0, 2, 0, 2, 0). (28, 31, 32, 34, 36, 38, 40, 42, 44 sts)

Step 4: K to beg of rnd.

Rep step 4 for 50 (51, 54, 57, 60, 62, 65, 66, 68) rnds. Cast off all sts

FINISHING & ASSEMBLY

Step 1: Lay front panel on back panel, WS together, and sew along each shoulder seam.

Step 2: With 10mm knitting needles, pick up and knit 17 (18, 21, 22, 22, 24, 25, 25, 26) along front neckline and 15 (16, 17, 17, 18, 20, 20, 22, 22) sts along back neckline. (32, 34, 38, 39, 40, 44, 45, 47, 48 sts)

Step 3: Work in 1x1 rib for 3 rnds. Cast off all sts.

Step 4: Find the centre point of the top of the sleeve, and match to the shoulder seam. Sew the sleeve to the body. Rep for the second sleeve.

Step 6: Weave in all ends.



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
