LADIES RIBBED SWEATER

BREEN AND SUPERWASH DK

MEASUREMENTS

To fit bust 36/38 and 40/42 in [92/97 and 102/107 cm]

Actual chest measurement 43 and 48 in [109[122 cm]

Sleeve length to underarm 17 in [43 cm]

MATERIALS

Cygnat Breen DK shade 3222 Trollstigen (M) 3 x 100g balls

Cygnat Pure Wool Superwash DK 50g shade 208 White (C) 5 x 50g balls

Owing to photography and printing restrictions, the colour reproduction is matched as closely as possible to the yarn

A pair of 3.25 mm and 4 mm (US 3 and 6) knitting needles.

TENSION

22 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm, 4 ins measured over stocking stitch on 4 mm needles.

IT IS IMPORTANT TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION IN ORDER TO OBTAIN THE CORRECT MEASUREMENTS

If fewer stitches are obtained use a thicker needle, if more use a thinner needle

ABBREVIATIONS

K knit

P purl

St(s) stitch(es)

Stst stocking stitch (1 row K, 1 row P)

Rept repeat

In inches

Cm centimetres

Beg beginning

Ws wrong side

Rs right side

Patt pattern

Dec decreasing

Rem remaining

BACK

With smaller needle and C cast on 120[132] sts and work in 2 x 2 rib for 8 in (20 cm) end with a ws row.

Change to larger needles and work 4 in (10 cm) in stst.

Break off C and Join in M.

Armhole Shaping

Cont in stst, cast off 7 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 106[118] sts.

Dec one st at each end of next and every alt row 6[8] times.

Now dec at each end of every 4th row 2 times. 90[98]sts.

Work straight until armholes measure 5[5 ½]in, 12.5[14] cm ending with a P row.

Shape Back Neck

Next row(rs): K35[39] sts, turn and work on these sts only.

*Dec one st at neck edge in every row to 15[19]sts.

Work straight until armhole measures 8[8 ½]in,

20.5[21.5]cm end with a ws row.

Cast off for shoulders.*

With rs facing, rejoin yarn, cast off centre 20 sts and K to end. Complete as given for first side of neck from * to *

FRONT

Work as for Back until Front measures 16[16 ½] in 40.5[42] cm from beg, ending with a ws row.

Shape Front Neck

Next row(rs): K30[34] sts, turn and work on these sts only.

*Dec one st at neck edge in every row to 15[19]sts.

Work straight until armhole measures 8[8 ½]in 20.5[21.5]cm.

Cast off for shoulders.*

With rs facing, rejoin yarn, cast off centre 30 sts and K to end.

Complete as given for first side of neck from * to *

SLEEVES

With smaller needle and C cast on 94(98) sts and work in 2 x 2 rib for 10 in (25 cm) end with a ws row.

Change to larger needles and work 7 in (18 cm) in stst.

Break off C and Join in M.

Shape Top

Cont in stst, cast off 7 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 80[84] sts
Dec one st at each end of every row 5 times to 70[74] sts , then each end of every alt row 2[4] times to 66 sts then every foll 4th row 6 times to 54 sts then every alt row 6 times to 44 sts, then every row 7 times.

Cast off rem 30 sts.

NECKBAND

Join left shoulder seam

With right side facing and using smaller needle and yarn C, pick up and K21 sts evenly down side of back neck, 20 sts across centre back, 21 sts up side of back neck, 26 sts down

side of front neck, 30 sts across centre front and 26 sts up side of neck. 144 sts
Work 10 rows in 2 x 2 rib.
Cast off in rib.

FINISHING OFF

Join right shoulder and neckband seam.
Set in sleeves.
Join side and sleeve seams.

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
