Needles			Tension		
1 pair 12mm straight or circular needles			10cm / 4 inch square: 8 stitches over 11 rows		
1 pair 10mm straight or circular needles			working in stocking stitch.		
IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE THE CORRECT SIZING. If you tension square has less stitches, use a thinner needle, if more, use a thicker needle.

BACK

With 10mm needles and Col A

cast on 40[44:48:52]sts.

Row 1: (k2, p2) to end

Row 2: (k2, p2) to end

Last two rows form 2x2 rib.

Continue in 2x2 rib until back measures 2½ ins (6cm).

Change to 12mm needles and Col C and work 4 rows in stst.

Change to Col B and work 4 rows in stst.

Last 8 rows form stripe patt.

Continue in patt until Back measures 24[25:26:27]ins (61[63.5:66:68.5]cm).**

Continuing in stripe patt work as follows:

Cast off 5[6:7:8]sts at beginning of next 4 rows.

Cast off remaining 20 sts loosely.

FRONT

Work as for Back up to **, but working 2 less rows. Continue in stripe patt as follows:

Next row: k12[14:16:18], turn and continue working on these sts.

Next row: p2tog, purl to end (11[13:15:17]sts)

Next row: knit

Next row: p2tog, purl to end (10[12:14:16]sts)

Next row: cast off 5[6:7:8]sts, knit to end (5[6:7:8]sts)

Next row: purl

Next row: cast off remaining 5[6:7:8]sts

Rejoin yarn to the remaining 28[30:32:34]sts and, working in stripe patt, cast off next 16 sts, knit to end (12[14:16:18]sts)

Next row: purl to last 2 sts, p2tog (11[13:15:17]sts)

Next row: knit

Next row: purl to last 2 sts, p2tog (10[12:14:16]sts)

Next row: knit

Next row: cast off 5[6:7:8]sts,
purl to end (5[6:7:8]sts)

Next row: knit

Next row: cast off remaining
5[6:7:8]sts

SLEEVES (make two)

With 10mm needles and Col A,
cast on 24[26:28:30]sts

Work in 2x2 rib until sleeve
measures 2ins (5cm).

**Change to 12mm needles and
Col C** and working in stripe
pattern and stst, inc 1 st at each
end of next and foll 6th row until
there are 36[38:40:42]sts.

Work 4 more rows and cast off
loosely.

NECKBAND

Join left shoulder seam.

**With rs facing and 10mm
needles and Col A,** pick up and
knit 18 sts across back neck, 4 sts
down left front neck, 14 sts
across front neck and 4 sts up
right front neck. (40sts)

Work 2 rows in 2x2 rib.

Cast off loosely in rib.

Making up

Join right shoulder seam. Fold
sleeves in half lengthways and
pin and stitch in place. Join
sleeve and side seams.



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
