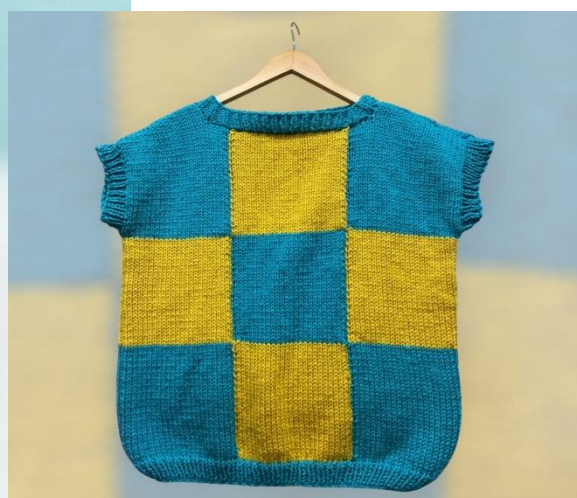




CY1909 CHECKERED VEST CYGNET CHUNKY

MEASUREMENTS

To Fit Bust Actual Measurement 98(107:115) cm [39 ½ (43:46 ¼) in]

MATERIALS

Cygnets Chunky 100g 2[2:3] balls of both shades (A) Sea Foam 449 and (B) Gold 686

Cygnets Chunky 100g 2[2:3] balls of shades (A) White 208 and (B) Mint 601 plus 1 ball of Pink 813 (C)

The quantities of yarn stated are based upon average requirements and are therefore approximate.
A pair of 6.5 mm (UK 10 – US10.5) Knitting needles

Tension:

14 sts and 19 rows to 10 cm, 4 in, measured over stocking stitch using 6.5 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

VERY IMPORTANT: IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.

If there are less stitches and rows to 10cm, 4in, than the number stated, change to a finer needle, if there are more stitches and rows than stated change to a larger needle.

NOTES: Instructions are given for 98 cm, 39 ½ in, larger sizes are given in brackets.

Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes.

Owing to photography and printing restrictions, the colour reproduction is matched as closely as possible to the yarn

Abbreviations:

TWO COLOURED VERSION

Do not strand yarn across back of work use a separate ball for each square

BACK AND FRONT (Both alike)

Using 6.5 mm needles and yarn A, cast on 67[73,79]sts and work 6 rows in K1, P1 rib, inc one st at each end of last row. 69[75,81] sts.

Join in yarn B across next row.

Commence pattern.

1st row: (rs) Using B, K23(25,27), Using A, K23(25,27), Using B, K23(25,27).

2nd row: Using B, P23(25,27), Using A, P23(25,27), Using B, P23(25,27).

Rept last 2 rows until 30[34,36] rows have been worked.

Next row: (rs) Using A, K23(25,27), Using B, K23(25,27), Using A, K23(25,27).

2nd row: Using A, P23(25,27), Using B, P23(25,27), Using A, P23(25,27).

Rept last 2 rows until 30[34,36] rows have been worked.

This completes the chequerboard pattern

Keep chequerboard alternating squares pattern correct throughout

Work a further 30[34,36] rows in patt.

Shape Shoulders and Neck

1st row Patt 24[26,28] sts, turn and work on these sts only.

2nd row Cast off 4 sts at neck edge, Patt to end.

3rd row Patt to last 2 sts, work2tog.

4th row Patt to end.

5th row Cast off 7[7,8]sts at shoulder edge, Patt to end.

6th row Patt to end.

7th row Cast off 6[7,8] sts at shoulder edge, Patt to end. Cast off rem 6[7,7]sts.

With rs facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 21[23,25]sts and Patt to end.

2nd row: Patt to end.

3rd row: Cast off 4 sts at neck edge, patt to end.

4th row: Patt to last 2 sts, work2tog.

5th row: Patt to end.

6th row: Cast off 7[7,8] sts, Patt to end.

7th row: Patt to end.

8th row: Cast off 6[7,8] sts, Patt to end.
Cast off rem 6[7,7]sts.

NECK EDGING

Join right shoulder seam.

With rs facing and using yarn A, starting at left shoulder seam, pick up and K5 sts down left side of front neck, 21[23,25] sts from centre front, pick up and k5 sts up right side of front neck, 5 sts down right side of back neck, pick up and K21[23,25]sts from centre back and pick up and K4 sts up left side of back neck. 61[65,69] sts.
Work 5 rows in K1, P1 rib. Cast off loosely.

ARMBANDS

Join left shoulder and neckband seam.

Place a marker on back and fronts 10 in (26 cm) down from each shoulder seam.

With rs facing and using yarn A, pick up and K 53 sts evenly between markers.

Work 5 rows in K1, P1 rib. Cast off loosely.

FINISH OFF

Join side seams and armband seams

Block out finished garment

3 COLOURED VERSION

Work all the rib sections in yarn C, using photo as a guide.

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
