Yoked Sweater

Breen and Superwash DK

Measurements

Actual Measurement 106 cm (42 in)

Length 55cm (22 in)

Materials

4 mm (US 6) and 4.5 mm (US 7) long and short circular needles.

4 mm (US 6) long and short Double Pointed Needles (dpn's)

Stitch Markers

2 X 100g balls (A) Breen DK shade Polar Night 3333

7 x 50g balls (B) Superwash DK shade Raspberry 2151 and 1 x 50g ball (C) Bluebell 2156

Tension:

19 sts and 27 rows to 10 cm, 4 ins measured over stst on 4 mm needles

If fewer stitches are obtained use a thinner needle, if more use a thicker needle

IT IS IMPORTANT TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION IN ORDER TO OBTAIN THE REQUIRED MEASUREMENTS

Abbreviations:

K Knit	beg beginning	inc increase
st(s) stitch(es)	tog together	dec decrease
rnd round	rept repeat	sm slip marker
PM place marker	RH right hand	cont continue

Special Abbreviations:

ssk slip one st knitwise, slip one st purlwise, k 2 slipped sts tog through back of loops

m1 make one st by picking up loop before next st and K into back of it

Note: Use either dpn's or different sizes of circular needles for ease when working across varying amounts of stitches

BODY

This seamless sweater is worked in the round from the bottom up

Using 4mm circular needle and C, cast on 202 sts. Join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist.
PM to mark beg of rnd.

Rib rnd: * K1, P1, rept from * to end.

Rept this row for 4cm.

Break off Blue and join in B.

Change to 4.5 mm circular needle and cont in stst until work measures 32 cm from beg end the final rnd 2 sts before marker.

****** Cast off 4 sts, K until there are 97 sts on the RH needle, rept from ****** once more. 97 sts each for Front and Back. 194 sts in total. Break yarn.

Note: For Sleeves use either a smaller circular needle or use dpns to fit the sts on to the

needles for ease when working.

SLEEVES (Both alike)

Using 4mm dpn's and C, cast on 40 sts. Join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist. PM to mark beg of rnd.

Rib rnd * K1, P1, rept from * to end.

Rept this row for 4cm.

Break off C and join in B.

Change to 4.5mm dpn's.

Work 5 rnds.

Join in A and work last 6 rnds once more.

Next rnd (inc) K2, m1, K to last 2 sts, m1, K2. 42 sts

Join in A and work next

6 rnds once more. Break off A and continue in B.

Rept the last **6 rnds** 7 times more. 56 sts.

Work 3 rnds.

Next rnd (inc) K2, m1, K to last 2 sts, m1, K2. 58 sts
Rept last **4 rnds** 12 more times. 82 sts.

Work straight until Sleeve measures 46 cm, ending final rnd 2 sts before marker. Cast off 4 sts, K to end. 78 sts. Break yarn.

Do not break yarn for second sleeve

When working the 2nd sleeve, for the border try to match the colourway similar to that of the other sleeve.

YOKE

(Using A throughout)

Joining rnd PM after the 78 sts for left sleeve (the ones already on the needle) K across 97 sts of front of body, PM, k across 78 sts held for

right sleeve, PM, K across rem 97 sts for back of body, PM for beg of rnd (between back and left sleeve). 350 sts.

Shape raglan

Next rnd (dec) * K2tog, K to 2 sts before next marker, ssk, sm, rept from * 3 more times. 8 sts decreased. 342 sts

Work one rnd.

Cont rept last **2 rnds** 30 more times. 102 sts.

Next rnd: work one rnd.

Break off A and join in C.

Change to 4 mm dpn's.

Rib rnd * K1, P1, rept from * to end.

Rept this rnd for 4 cm.

Cast off loosely in rib.

FINISHING OFF

Join underarm seam on each side.

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
