



CY1342 BOHO SPIRIT
DREAM SUMMER SHAWL

Materials:

2 x 100g balls Boho Spirit shade Dream 6943

5 mm crochet hook

Darning needle

Piece of cardboard to make tassels

Pattern notes:

UK terminology used

This pattern is an easy 1 row repeat

The size of the shawl can be made longer or shorter by making more or less rows.

The chain 4 at the beginning of the row counts as a double treble crochet

When working the peak – work 4 treble crochet + chain 1 + 4 treble crochet all into the chain 2 space from the row before

Abbreviations	ch - chain	st - stitch	vst(s) – v stitch(s) tc + ch 2 + tc
tc - treble crochet	sk – skip	rem - remaining	peak - 4 tc + ch 1 + 4 tc
dtr – double treble crochet	slst - slip stitch	t - turn your work	
	rept - repeat	nxt - next	

Ch 5, slst to the 1st ch to form into a ring

Row 1 - ch 4, into ring work, 4 tc + ch 2 + 4 tc + 1 dtr

Row 2 - ch 4, t, 2 tc into base of ch 4, sk 2, vst into nxt, sk 1, peak into ch 2 sp, sk 1, vst into nxt, sk 2, into 3rd ch of 4 work 2 tc + dtr

Row 3 - ch 4, t, 2 tc into base of ch 4, [vst into the sps bet the vsts] twice, peak into ch 2 sp, [vst into the sps bet the vsts] twice, into 3rd ch of 4 work 2 tc + dtr

continue working as row 3 with the following increases -

Row 4 - ch 4, t, 2 tc into base of ch, v-st into nxt 3 sps, peak, v-st into nxt 3 sps, into 3rd ch of 4, 2 tc + dtr

Row 5 - ch 4, t, 2 tc into base of ch, v-st into nxt 4 sps, peak, v-st into nxt 4 sps, into 3rd ch of 4, 2 tc + dtr

Row 6 - ch 4, t, 2 tc into base of ch, v-st into nxt 5 sps, peak, v-st into nxt 5 sps, into 3rd ch of 4, 2 tc + dtr

Row 7 - ch 4, t, 2 tc into base of ch, v-st into nxt 6 sps, peak, v-st into nxt 6 sps, into 3rd ch of 4, 2 tc + dtr

Row 8 - ch 4, t, 2 tc into base of ch, v-st into nxt 7 sps, peak, v-st into nxt 7 sps, into 3rd ch of 4, 2 tc + dtr

Row 9 - ch 4, t, 2 tc into base of ch, v-st into nxt 8 sps, peak, v-st into nxt 8 sps, into 3rd ch of 4, 2 tc + dtr

Row 10 - ch 4, t, 2 tc into base of ch, v-st into nxt 9 sps, peak, v-st into nxt 9 sps, into 3rd ch of 4, 2 tc + dtr

Keep repeating the Row until your Shawl if your desired Length, remembering to leave enough yarn if you wish to make Tassels

To make tassels – Make 3

- Cut a piece of cardboard 6 “ in height
- Cut 6 lengths of yarn, slightly longer than the height of your tassel
- Wrap your yarn around the cardboard 15 times
- Slip one piece of yarn though the centre and tie tightly at the top
- Slide the tassel off the cardboard and lay flat on top of a piece of yarn that is laying horizontal
- Tie tightly around about 2 cm from the top
- Use a darning needle to feed these lengths though the centre to blend them in
- Use the 1st length tied at the top. to attach to the shawl on all 3 corners
- Use a darning needle to feed these lengths back down though the centre to blend them in
- Trim Neatly
