BREEN CROCHET SCARF

Measurements

Finished scarf - 260 cm x 15 cm

Materials

Cygnet Breen DK 100g - Arctic Bellflower (3777) x 2 balls

Cygnet DK 100g - Lt Mauve (1048) x 1 ball

4.5mm crochet hook, tapestry needle

Abbreviations

ch	Chain	tr	treble stitch	sp	space
st	Stitch	ss	slip stitch		

Pattern

Solid squares (make 6)

Round 1: Using yarn A, make a magic circle, ch 3, 2tr, *ch 2, 3tr; repeat from * 2 more times, ch 2, join with a ss to top of ch 3.

Round 2: Ch 3, *(3tr, ch 2, 3tr) into next sp; repeat from * 2 more times, (3tr, ch 2, 2tr) in the last sp, ss to top of ch 3.

Round 3: Ch 3, 2tr in same sp, *(3tr, ch 2, 3tr) into next sp, 3tr; repeat from * 2 more times, (3tr, ch 2, 3tr), join with a ss to top of ch 3.

Round 4: Ch 3, 3tr, *(3tr, ch 2, 3tr) into next sp, 3tr in next 2 sp; repeat from * 2 more times, (3tr, ch 2, 3tr) into next sp, 2tr, join with a ss to top of ch 3.

Round 5: Ch 3, 2tr in same sp, 3tr, *(3tr, ch 2, 3tr) into next sp, 3tr in next 3 sp; repeat from * 2 more times, (3tr, ch 2, 3tr) into next sp, 3tr, join with a ss to top of ch 3, fasten off.

50/50 squares (make 12)

Round 1: Using yarn A, make a magic circle, ch 3, 2tr, ch 2, 3tr, ch 1, change to yarn B, ch 1, ch 2, 3tr ch 2, join with a ss to top of ch 3, fasten off.

Round 2: Using yarn A, join yarn in the last ch 2 created in round 1, ch 3, 2tr in same sp, (3tr, ch 2, 3tr) into next sp, 3tr, ch 1, change to yarn B, ch 1, 3tr in same sp, (3tr, ch 2, 3tr), 3 tr, ch 2, join with a ss to top of ch 3, fasten off.

Round 3: Using yarn A, join yarn in the last ch 2 created in round 1, ch 3, 2tr in same sp, 3tr, (3tr, ch 2, 3tr) into next sp, 3tr in next 2 sp, ch 1, change to yarn B, ch 1, 3tr in same sp, 3tr, (3tr, ch 2, 3tr), 3tr in next 2 sp, ch 2, join with a ss to top of ch 3, fasten off.

Round 4: Using yarn A, join yarn in the last ch 2 created in round 1, ch 3, 2tr in same sp, 3tr in next 2 sp, (3tr, ch 2, 3tr) into next sp, 3tr in next 3 sp, ch 1, change to yarn B, ch 1, 3tr in same sp, 3tr in next 2 sp, (3tr, ch 2, 3tr), 3tr in

next 3 sp, ch 2, join with a ss to top of ch 3, fasten off.

Round 5: Using yarn A, join yarn in the last ch 2 created in round 1, ch 3, 2tr in same sp, 3tr in next 3 sp, (3tr, ch 2, 3tr) into next sp, 3tr in next 4 sp, ch 1, change to yarn B, ch 1, 3tr in same sp, 3tr in next 3 sp, (3tr, ch 2, 3tr), 3tr in next 4 sp, ch 2, join with a ss to top of ch 3, fasten off.

Sew in all ends and block if necessary.

Joining Squares

To join the squares, use a long length of the appropriately coloured yarn and a darning needle. Holding the squares front sides together, whip stitch through the back loops of the sides that need to join.

The pattern is as follows: 50/50 square x 2, solid square x 1; repeat. The 50/50 squares need to be joined together with the solid section (yarn B) creating a triangle.

Once you have joined all the squares in a long length, hold the first and last squares together (ensuring that the scarf isn't twisted) and sew the ends together to create a continuous loop.
