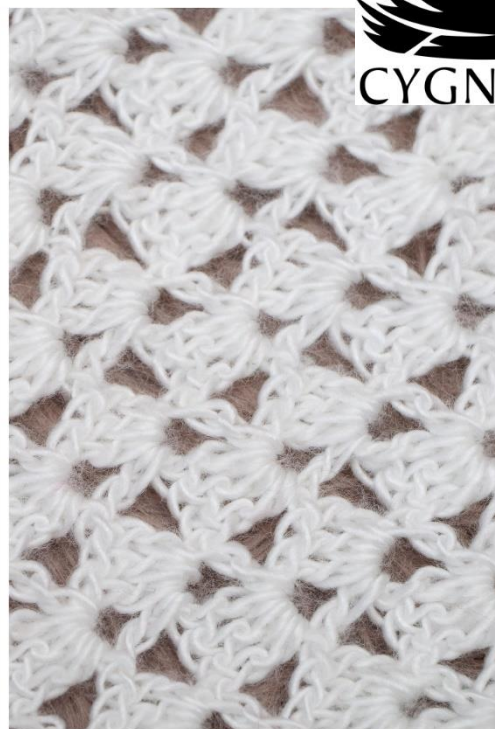




CY1 260 BOHO SPIRIT LACY SCARF

You Will need –

2 x 100g Balls Cygnet Boho in Pure 6208

5mm Crochet Hook

Darning Needle

Pattern Notes

UK Terminology used

The chain 3 at the beginning of the row counts as a treble crochet.

This pattern is an easy 1 row repeat and consists of just treble crochet and Chains.

The Starting chain for this pattern to make it wider, is a multiple of 5 + 4.

Abbreviations –

TC - treble Crochet

CH - chain

SK – skip

SS - slip stitch

REP - repeat

ST - stitch

REM - remaining

T - turn your work

NXT - next

SP - space

Pattern

CH 29

(This will give you 5 pattern repeats, to make it wider, see notes for starting chain multiple)

Row 1 – In 6th CH from the hook / ** 3 x TC + CH 2 + TC / SK 4 / REP from ** till 3 / SK 2 / TC in last

Row 2 – CH 3 / ** in the CH 2 SP / 3 x TC + CH 2 + TC / REP from ** across / 1 x TC in CH 3 SP

Row 3 till the end / REP row 2

Repeat Row 2 Until you have used the 2 balls.

Fasten off, weave in ends.



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
